Connect Amazon Alexa with Alarm.com

Requirements

- A customer account powered by Alarm.com.
- Lights, thermostats, locks, garage doors, security panel, or camera powered by Alarm.com.
- A device with Amazon Alexa and associated Amazon customer account.

Important: The Amazon Alexa-powered device must be set to English.

To set up Alarm.com skill using voice commands:

1. Tell the Alexa enabled device: "Alexa, talk to Alarm.com." Alexa will respond that the Alarm.com account needs to be linked.

2. Open the Amazon Alexa app on a mobile device or go to Alexa.amazon.com using a web browser.

3. On the Home dashboard, an Alarm.com card will appear at the top of the app with a **Link Alarm.com Account** button.

Note: The Amazon Alexa app view may vary based on the device in use.



4. Tap Link Alarm.com Account and enter your Alarm.com login credentials.

Note: There will be a prompt asking to enable secure actions. Secure actions are security sensitive (unlock the door, open the garage, disarm the panel) and protected behind a four-digit pin. If interested, tap **Allow** (go to step 8) otherwise tap **Deny** (go to step 9).
